6. Executive Session

Pursuant to Texas Government Code, annotated, Chapter 551 Subchapter D:

- a. Section 551.071 authorizes a governmental body to consult with its attorney in an executive session to seek his or her advice on a legal matter. It provides as follows: A governmental body may not conduct a private consultation with its attorney except: (1) When the governmental body seeks the advice of its attorney about: (a) pending or contemplated litigation; or (b) a settlement offer; or (2) on a matter in which the duty of the attorney to the governmental body under the Texas Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct of the State Bar of Texas clearly conflicts with this chapter. The Town Council may adjourn into executive session for consultation with the Town Attorney regarding:
 - i. Legal advice on any matter related to any posted agenda item;
 - ii. Legal advice related to development and annexation of the Chadwick Tracts, 6-acre and 3-acre tracts of land generally located at the corner of Cleveland Gibbs Road and Chadwick Parkway; and
 - iii. Legal advice related to development and annexation of the Henderson Tracts, seven tracts totaling 146 acres of land generally located at the southwest corner of FM 156 and Harmonson Road; and the development of the 6McFarm tracts totaling approximately

- 234.4 acres of land generally located north and east of Harmonson Road approx. 2,358 feet north of Victory Circle; and
- iv. Legal advice related to the development and annexation of the Hatfield, Brasher, Green Tract on approximately 97.9 acre tract of land generally located south of Evelyn Lane, west of Faught Road and north of Faith Lane in the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the Town; and the development of the Charles Faught tracts totaling approximately 102.3 acres of land generally located north of Evelyn Lane, west of Faught Road, and south of Robson Ranch Road
