5. ACTION ITEMS

Consider Ordinance 22-0601A on proposed text amendments to Section 4.3 "Notice Requirements" and Article 5 "Zoning Districts" of the Unified Development Code (UDC) to require written notices to be mailed to property owners within 200 feet of the boundary of the larger parent tract if the property in question is a portion of that tract. Case # UDC-22-002

6. EXECUTIVE SESSION

The Town Council will convene in an Executive Session, pursuant to Texas Government Code, annotated, Chapter 551 Subchapter D:

a. Section 551.071 - Consultation with Attorney

The Town Council may convene in an executive session to consult with its attorney to seek advice on a legal matter. It provides as follows: A governmental body may not conduct a private consultation with its attorney except: (1) When the governmental body seeks the advice of its attorney about: (a) pending or contemplated litigation; or (b) a settlement offer; or (2) on a matter in which the duty of the attorney to the governmental body under the Texas Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct of the State Bar of Texas clearly conflicts with this chapter. The Town Council may adjourn into executive session for consultation with the Town Attorney regarding:

- Development and annexation of the Revival Fire tract on approximately 5.1 acres of land generally located east of Florance Road and north of Hill Ridge Drive in the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the Town.
- ii. Town of Northlake vs. RKM Utility Services Inc. & Philadelphia Indemnity Insurance Company Denton County District Court Cause No. 20-0649-367.
- iii. Development of Charles Faught tracts totaling approximately 152.3 acres of land generally located north of Evelyn Lane, west of Faught Road, and south of Robson Ranch Road.

b. Section 551.074 - Personnel Matters

The Town Council may convene in an executive session to discuss or deliberate regarding the to deliberate the appointment, employment, evaluation, reassignment, duties, discipline, or dismissal of a public officer or employee.

i. Town Manager Evaluation.

c. Section 551.087 - Economic Development Negotiations

The Town Council may convene in an executive session to discuss or deliberate regarding commercial or financial information that the Town has received from a business prospect that the Town seeks to have locate, stay, or expand in or near the Town and with which the Town is conducting economic development negotiations; or to deliberate the offer of a financial or other incentive to a business prospect described below.

- Potential development agreement with Henry Northlake Development LLC on five tracts totaling approximately 122 acres generally located east of I-35W and north of Denton Creek.
- ii. Potential development agreement and annexation of the CKD Holdings Tracts on approximately 24.8-acre, 11.9-acre, and 1.8-acre tracts of land generally located north of Oliver Creek and west of FM 156 in the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the Town.

7. RECONVENE INTO OPEN SESSION

In accordance with Texas Government Code, Section 551, the Town Council will reconvene into Open Session and consider action, if any, on matters discussed in Executive Session

a. Consider authorizing the Town Manager to take all necessary actions and execute all necessary documents regarding the development agreement with Henry Northlake Development, LLC, pertaining to approximately 122 acres generally located east of I-35W and north of Denton Creek
